II. Sanitary Information

I ----- the under signed Official Veterinarian have examined today and showed no clinical signs of infectious and contagious diseases.

1. Country or zone free for the following diseases for a specified period prior to shipment:

- Rift Valley Fever: since birth or for at least 14 days prior to shipment; or did not transit through an area experiencing an epizootic during transportation to the place of shipment; or were protected from vector attacks when transiting through an area experiencing an epizootic.
- Vesicular stomatitis since birth or for at least 21 days.
- Paratuberculosis since birth or 12 months prior to shipment.

2. Establishment in which no case reported officially for the following diseases for a specified period prior to shipment;

- a. Anthrax 20 days;
- b. Peste des petits ruminants(PPR), sheep and goat pox: since birth, or for at least the 21 days, Contagious caprine pleuropneumonia for goats only since birth or 45 days, and that the establishment was not situated in a infected zone; were vaccinated against PPR with live attenuated PPRV vaccines at least 21 days prior to shipment; not less than 15 days and not more than 4 months prior to shipment for sheep and goat pox,
- c. Rabies for at least 12 months or were vaccinated or revaccinated in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturer.
- d. Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) since birth, or for the past 3 months, FMD has not occurred within a ten-kilometre radius of the establishment; were not exposed to any source of FMD infection during their transportation from the quarantine station to the place of shipment.

2.3. Brucellosis: country or zone free from infection or herd or flock free from infection (a) test required) or if herd or flock not qualified for free in which no case reported during the year (b) test required).

2.4. Ovine epididymitis (Brucella ovis): (except castrated male) flock free, or if flock other than free(a) test required)

2.6. Bluetongue: animals were kept in a vector-protected establishment for at least 60 days prior to shipment and during transportation to the place of shipment; or a vector-protected establishment for at least 28 days prior to shipment and during transportation to the place of shipment(a) test is required) or were kept vector-protected establishment for at least 14 days prior to shipment and during transportation to the place of shipment(b) test is required),

2.8. Scrapie animals come from an establishment free from scrapie as described in Article 14.8.5.

2.9. Old and New world screwworm: country if infested comply with the OIE Terrestrial Code 2014 article 8.10.1 to 8.10.3.

2.10. Vaccination: have been vaccinated for the following diseases

- a. PPR 14 days prior to shipment.
- b. Sheep and goat pox not less than 15 days and not more than 12 months prior to shipment.

2.11. Laboratory tests: required negative results, test approved by the OIE Manual.

- a. Brucellosis (a)sexually matured animals30 days prior to shipment; (b) isolated for 30 days and tested during this period; in the case of post-parturient females, the test was carried out at least 30 days after giving birth
- b. Ovine epididymitis (Brucella ovis): (a)sheep over 6 months of age 30 days prior to shipment.
- c. Foot and Mouth Disease Virus (FMDV)(virology and serology) 28 days after isolation.
- d. Bluetongue virus antibody(a) 28 days after introduction into the vector protected establishment or BTV (b)14 days after introduction into the vector protected establishment;

2.12. do not come from an area under veterinary restriction due to an outbreak of an infectious disease; and must not be animals which have been culled under a national program to control and eradicate a contagious or infectious disease

2.13. have been effectively treated against internal (including effective drugs against liver fluke) and external parasites;

2.14.were derived from flock where other OIE listed diseases have not occurred during the past 1 month prior to shipment;

2.15. were kept in a vector proof quarantine station approved by the Veterinary Authority of the country for at least 21 days prior to shipment;

2.16. were sent directly from the holding of the origin and have not come in contact with other animals; were not passed through an area with and exposed to an infectious or contagious disease outbreak during their transit to the place of shipment;

2.17. The facilities by which animals are transported from the source of the farm to their destination and the way they are handled during the journey should comply with the Animal Welfare standards of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code 2011, chapter 7.2.or 7.4,

2.18. Validity of the International Veterinary Certificate
